1. Who can apply?

Researchers, teachers and professors wishing to join Aix-Marseille Université's research and teaching site. The program is opened to all fields and disciplines. Applicants *must* meet the following criteria (incomplete applications and those that do not meet the eligibility criteria will not be evaluated):

- PhD diploma
- Minimum 4 years of research/teaching experience after obtaining the PhD
- External applicants only (i.e. no internal recruitment to the Aix-Marseille site for a Chair of Excellence) with the exception of applicant for the "disability" position
- Teacher-researchers holding a permanent position in France are not eligible

For candidates for an "ERC" Chair of Excellence, only candidates with ERC grant will be eligible. The ERC Grant should not have started more than 36 months before the application date.

For the "Disability" Chair of excellence only candidates with disability can be considered for this type of chair.

Academic staff cannot be older than 67 years old, if you were born before 1961 we will not be able to hire you for the project. This offer is not intended for teacher-researchers who already hold a permanent teacher-researchers position in France.

2. Call for application deadline

Applications should be submitted before **October 31, 2023**.

For the "ERC" Chairs of Excellence, or for disabled Chairs of Excellence applications may be submitted at **any time**.

3. How to apply?

➤ Identify possible collaborations

Applicants are encouraged to identify and contact research units or structures with which they wish to collaborate before sending their application (see information about the Aix-Marseille research and teaching site below).

➤ Prepare you research, teaching and integration project

The research, teaching and integration plan must briefly present your most important work and achievements and propose a research and teaching plan as well as a description of the integration of your project within the research units, faculties, infrastructures, etc. of Aix-Marseille.

Maximum 4 pages (excluding references), in English. There is no formal model for this document.

For ERC laureates, the plan should indicate the laureate plans on transferring and using the ERC grant.

➤ **Update your online profiles to provide us with:**

- Updated **online ORCID public profile** including: previous employment, education, fundings, works ... (mandatory). Your ORCID profile should have all the needed information to evaluate your profile
- At least one of the following **publications list** (mandatory): GoogleScholarID (strongly recommended) and/or PublonsResearcherID (recommended), or ScopusID (recommended)

➤ **Submit your application online, answer a few questions and send your documents**

Questions and information you will be asked to provide:

- Links to online profiles (ORCID and GoogleScholar, Publons, Scopus)
- Identification: last name, first name, gender, nationality, year of birth
- Current status: current position, country, employer
- Previous applications to researcher positions in France
- Date of phd
- Main field
- Identified Aix-Marseille structure (research unit, faculty etc.)
- ERC laureate status (to apply to the position reserved for ERC laureates)
- Disabled status (to apply to the position reserved for disabled person)
- Information about the project (title, abstract, discipline ...)

Documents:

- Research teaching and integration plan (mandatory)
- Letter(s) of support from one or more structures on the Aix-Marseille site (research unit, research and teaching institutes, faculties, etc.) (optional but strongly recommended)
- Letter(s) of recommendation, or other supporting documents (optional).
- For applicant to the “Handicap” chair, if you have (optional): a worker’s certificate (RQTH for France) or another administrative certificate; (confirmation of compatibility of status will be assessed later during the selection process). Do not share personal or medical information.
- For ERC laureates only, you will be asked later in the selection process: the ERC project evaluation, the ERC project proposal and the grant agreement.

The experts will evaluate your profile using information available in the ORCID public profile, the online list of publication, and the short project. They will not ask for references. Other non-mandatory supporting documents (recommendation letters, support letters etc.) will be accepted only on the online application form.

3. Excellence Chair program and objectives in short

Objectives: to attract and retain exceptional scientific and teaching talent on the Aix-Marseille research and teaching site:

- Conduct strategic recruitment of scientific/educational profiles, external profiles capable of leading innovative projects (research, pedagogy), of developing new scientific themes, or of reinforcing the excellence of the site in an existing theme;
- To recruit excellent/high-level researchers/teaching researchers on the Aix-Marseille site, capable of obtaining an ERC grant on the Aix-Marseille site within the next 5 years;
- Attract and recruit ERC laureates to the site (specific Chair of excellence for ERC laureates);
- Amplify the long-term impact by encouraging subsequent stabilization (permanent positions);
- Promote the academic career of excellent teachers, researchers and professors with disabilities (specific for Chair of Excellence for persons with disabilities).

➤ Program in short

- A*Midex can cover the salary of the chairholder as well as a support package of up to €200 000 per year for 3 years
- Profile of the chairholder: researcher/teacher-researcher (team leader profile) or equivalent; external to the site (notably international);
- The call is open from 30th of June to October 31, 2023 (ongoing for ERC laureates and disabled candidates);
- Recruitment and start of the Chair of Excellence projects expected between October 2024 and March 2025 (to be determined);
- Annual call: 3 laureates selected per year, including 1 position reserved for a person with disability and 1 position reserved for an ERC laureate.

4. The excellence chair offers:

Working environment

A*Midex Foundation Excellence Chair offers project funding (project team (post-doctoral, PhD students, engineers...), operating expenses related to research, missions, equipment, in accordance with eligible IdEX expenses¹) up to 200 000€/year for 3 years

Salary and employment

- Salary determined according to experience and profile
- 3 years researcher/teacher-researcher contract (under CDD-LRU status: fixed-term contract for researchers or teachers²) with the possibility of 2 years possible renewal (on conditions and evaluation)

Mentoring

- The Chair of Excellence laureate may benefit, on a voluntary basis, from a mentoring program organized by the Ecole de Développement des Talents (EDT) in collaboration with the host organization. This mentoring program will take the form of regular meetings with a mentor in order to promote the integration of the laureate, his or her knowledge of the ecosystem and, more generally, the success of his or her professional project.

Aix-Marseille Université is [an Euraxess centre³](#) that helps researchers prepare for a successful stay in France and provides information on housing, banking, visas, health insurance, work and family benefits in France.

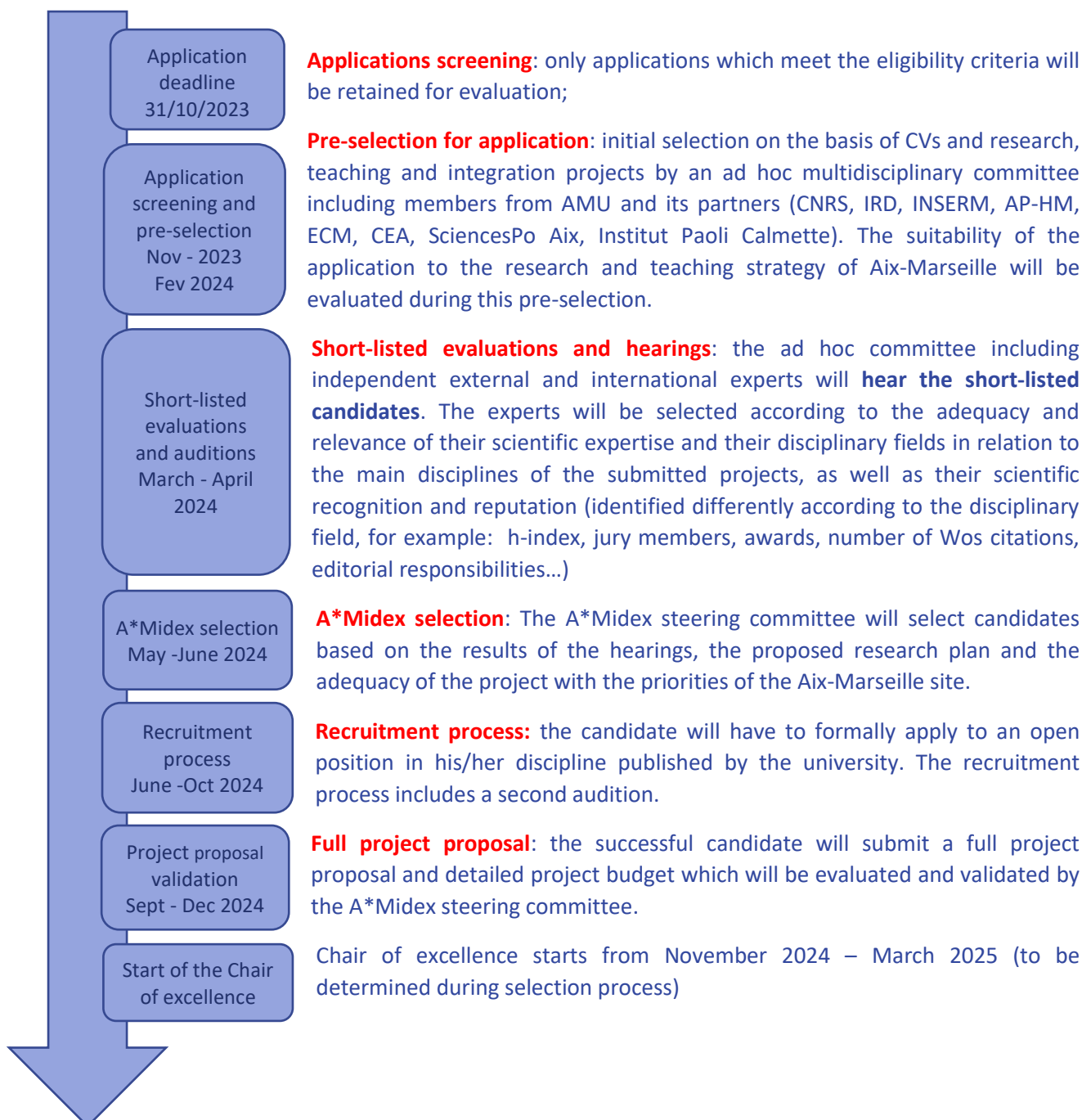

Selection criteria and process

A competitive multi-stage selection process, consistent with French employment laws and with A*Midex requirements for excellence, will be observed. The selection process will last at least 12 months and include two hearings for successful candidates. Candidates will be informed at each stage of the process.

4.2. Evaluation criteria (indicatives)

➤ Scientific and pedagogical excellence

- Quality and innovative aspect of the scientific project and quality of the scientific and/or pedagogical approach
- Scientific production (bibliometric, quality criteria) evaluated according to the discipline
- International recognition, or even world leadership in his/her field
- Post-doctoral experience (4 years minimum)
- Prestige of the institutions attended
- Ability to obtain funding (funding obtained, potential to obtain an ERC grant, motivation to fund research)
- Supervisory capacity (experience as a team leader)
- International background: experience outside France (research and/or teaching) (the evaluation of this criterion will consider the profile and gender of the candidate)
- For researcher or teacher/researcher profiles: recent A rating or good ERC ranking preferred, eligibility for those who have applied to a researcher position in France (CNRS, INSERM)
- For teacher or teacher/researcher profiles: teaching experience and quality of pedagogical proposals

➤ Relevance of the integration project

- Integration into the Aix-Marseille ecosystem (Aix-Marseille Université institutes, faculties, research units, technological platforms, etc.)
- Fluency in French appreciated

The profiles will be evaluated by experts trained on gender-based bias in selection according to Aix-Marseille Université gender equality and anti-discrimination policy.

5.About Aix-Marseille Université and A*Midex university foundation

Aix-Marseille Université (AMU) is the largest multidisciplinary French-speaking university. AMU welcomes 80,000 students and nearly 8,000 staff on 5 large campuses that meet international standards.
