

## CALL FOR TENDERS

### POST DOC - 2024

To strengthen the visibility and the attractiveness of the institute and allow young graduates researchers out their projects in one of the MarMaRa's research laboratories, the institute is opening positions for **post-doctoral fellows**.

Those Postdoctoral Fellowships are awarded for **a period of up to 12 months**. They intend to **support the candidate** for a few months **until the start of a longer funding or to allow the junction between 2 contracts** without a waiting period.

#### Eligibility criteria:

- Mobility is highly encouraged. International candidates holding a doctorate degree delivered by a non-French institution are welcome to apply
- To be eligible a significant proportion of the team members (students, non-permanent, permanent staff) must have been involved in the institute's activities<sup>1</sup> during the last and current academic year. If not, you commit to participate for the current and next academic year.

#### Evaluation:

The Scientific committee of MarMaRa will evaluate and select the candidate. The evaluation criteria will be the scientific quality of the project and the implementation (equipment, collaborations, staff involved, ...) of the hosting team.

#### Documents required :

- Application form (document to download on the [website](#)) with details of the previous employment's contracts
- CV and a list of publications of the applicant
