

CALL FOR TENDERS SCIENTIFIC EVENT 2024 - 2025

With the aim of strengthening research and improving the Institute's visibility at national, European and international level, MarMaRa wants to support its members' scientific events. A sponsoring grant of up to 1500€ will be awarded per scientific event.

Eligibility criteria:

- All members of the institute are eligible (engineer, PhD student, researcher...)
- The theme of the event must be related to one of the Institute's scientific axes.
- The event must take place between 1 September 2024 and 31 August 2025.
- The applicant must be one of the organisers of the scientific event and must be attached to one of the MarMaRa's teams.
- The event must be open to the entire scientific community (researchers, students).
- The event must be non-profitmaking.

Applications must be submitted at least two months before the planned date of the event.

Award conditions:

The following types of scientific event may be funded:

- National or international symposium
- Workshop or study day
- Scientific culture events (festivals, cultural events, etc.).

Courses, schools, or summer universities are not eligible, as are prestige meetings such as gala dinners.

Evaluation:

The Steering committee of MarMaRa will evaluate the applications throughout the year at the monthly meetings.

Documents required:

- Application form (document to download on the website)
- Program of the event
- CV and a list of publications of the applicant

Documents must be sent as a single file to Cecile Bernard, project manager of MarMaRa: cecile.bernard.1@univ-amu.fr

Terms of engagement:

The applicant commits that the institute will be mentioned and thanked in the communication of the event (before, during and after). If possible, the video presenting the institute will be shown during the inter-sessions.

All scientific publications and communications resulted from the event must mention the following sentence:

" This work received support from the French government under the France 2030 investment plan, as part of the Initiative d'Excellence d'Aix-Marseille Université - A*MIDEX (AMX-19-IET-007) through the Marseille Maladies Rares Institute (MarMaRa)."

Publications must be deposited in the A*Midex HAL AMU collection, the University's open archive.

Deadline

This call is open throughout the year.
