Since 1953, the SUL at Aix-Marseille University has been welcoming foreign students of different nationalities and offering them French language and culture courses at all levels of the CEFR. It is also involved in the professional development of FFL teachers abroad through the SUPFLES program.

Innovative and tailored training courses

The SUL offers half-yearly and annual courses in French language and culture **leading to a University Diploma (DU)**. It also offers weekly classes and intensive courses tailored to students' profiles and needs. In addition, **the SUL organises DALF and TCF exams**.

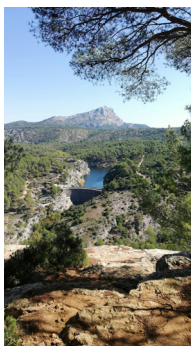

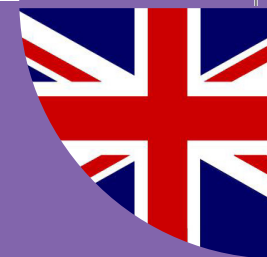

UNIVERSITY DEGREE (DU LCF)



The French language and cultural diploma offers **18 hours of French as a foreign language** per week. Students follow language courses and themed workshops tailored to their linguistic needs, with objectives ranging from **level A1 to C1** of the CEFR.

Creativity plays a very important role. The program is open to **all non-French-speaking adults** who have obtained their university entrance diploma or any higher diploma. The DU LCF awards 30 ECTS credits (European credits) for each semester, with mandatory attendance.

FLE-AMU



The SUL also offers 3 hours of lessons a week for 10 weeks to a wide range of people: students on mobility programs, doctoral students, AMU staff and non-residential students. The courses take place in Aix or Marseille, either face-to-face or online.

INTENSIVE SUMMER COURSES

The SUL offers intensive French language and culture courses that take into account the specific cultural characteristics of the Provence.



In addition to learning or perfecting the French language, activities are organised around the rich culture of Provence (artistic heritage, gastronomy, etc.).



SUPFLES

The SUL offers on-site or off-site University Professionalization Training Courses in FLE/S (SUPFLES) for teachers of French, in France and/or abroad, who wish to take part in a professionalization process. These courses provide an opportunity to reflect with other professionals in the field of FLE/S and to improve practices in different fields of FLE/S didactics.
